CIRCULAR

In compliance of the orders of Hon'ble the Chief Justice of India dated 20.10.2022 upon the recommendations made by the Chambers Allotment Committee of Hon'ble Judges, the procedure to be followed for vacation of the chamber(s) in unauthorized occupation by legal heirs of the deceased allottee or other occupants, is hereby notified for information of all:

“A Notice in regard to unauthorized occupation of the chamber by legal heirs of the deceased allottee or other occupants, may be pasted on the door of the said chamber informing that the possession of the chamber will be taken back within a week, on a particular date and time, by the Registry and if somebody is there he/she may surrender the chamber within the said period, failing which, the Registry will take possession by removing the lock and may take help of the local authorities, if need arises, at the sole risk, responsibility & cost of the legal heirs of the deceased allottee or other occupants of the chamber who may be in unauthorised occupation; further, the Registry will take appropriate action to disconnect the electricity connection and utility services of the said chamber on and from that date.”
