





CIRCULAR

It is hereby brought to the notice of all the Members of the Bar and the parties appearing in-person that the Competent Authority has been pleased to direct as under :-

- (1) Besides Monday the 4th January, 2016 and Friday the 8th January, 2016 which are already Miscellaneous days, Tuesday the 5th January, 2016 has also been declared as Miscellaneous day and Wednesday the 6th January, 2016 & Thursday the 7th January, 2016 shall be retained as Regular Hearing Days.
- (2) Fresh matters registered from 5th December, 2015 (Saturday) to 11th December, 2015 (Friday) will be listed on Monday the 14th December, 2015 and Wednesday the 16th December, 2015 in the chronological order of registration.
- (3) If all the fresh matters which will be registered from 5th December, 2015 (Saturday) to 11th December, 2015 (Friday) cannot be listed on Monday the 14th December, 2015 and Wednesday the 16th December, 2015, upto 20 fresh matters shall also be listed on Tuesday the 15th December, 2015 (Non Miscellaneous Day) in each Hon'ble Court.
- (4) Fresh matters registered from 12th December, 2015 (Saturday) to 23rd December, 2015 (Wednesday) shall be listed on 4th January, 2016 (Monday), 5th January, 2016 (Tuesday) and 8th January, 2016 (Friday) in the chronological order of date of registration.
- (5) If all the fresh matters which will be registered from 12th December, 2015 (Saturday) to 23rd December, 2015 (Wednesday) cannot be listed on the above-mentioned dates, the remaining fresh matters shall be listed in such a manner that besides the fresh matters to be listed on 8th January, 2016 (Miscellaneous Day), upto 20 fresh matters shall also be listed before each Court on Non-Miscellaneous days viz. 6th January, 2016 (Wednesday) and 7th January, 2016 (Thursday) strictly in chronological order of date of registration.
