CIRCULAR

It is hereby brought to the notice of all the Members of the Bar and the parties appearing in-person that the Competent Authority has been pleased to direct as under :-

- (1) The last week before ensuing summer vacation 2019 i.e. from 06.05.2019 (Monday) to 10.05.2019 (Friday) and the first week after Summer Vacation, 2019 i.e. from 01.07.2019 (Monday) to 05.07.2019 (Friday) shall be declared as Miscellaneous Weeks.
- (2) Fresh Matters, including 'short category' matters verified upto 06.05.2019 (Monday) shall be listed from 06.05.2019 (Monday) to 10.05.2019 (Friday) in the chronological order of their verification. Besides this pre-notice matters shall also be listed during the last miscellaneous week before summer vacation.
- (3) If the fresh matters verified upto 06.05.2019 (Monday) could not be listed during the miscellaneous week prior to the summer vacation, then such remaining fresh matters shall be listed during the first miscellaneous week, after the Summer Vacation in chronological order.
- (4) Fresh Matters, including 'short category' matters verified from 07.05.2019 to 01.07.2019 shall be listed from 01.07.2019 (Monday) to 05.07.2019 (Friday) after summer vacation in the chronological order of their verification.
- (5) If all the Fresh Matters verified upto 01st July, 2019 could not be accommodated during the miscellaneous week after summer vacation, then the remaining fresh matters together with the fresh matters verified on 02.07.2019 (Tuesday), 03.07.2019 (Wednesday) and 04.07.2019 (Thursday) shall be listed on 08.07.2019 (Monday).
- (6) In the event, if the fresh matters again could not be accommodated in the final cause list of 08.07.2019 (Monday), the remaining fresh matters shall be listed in chronological order on regular hearing days viz. 09.07.2019 (Tuesday), 10.07.2019 (Wednesday) and 11.07.2019 (Thursday) will be listed, besides the other matters already noted for these dates, including 'short category' matters.

Any deviation from above schedule will be intimated by the Registry at the relevant time for the information of all concerned.
